Pine Tip Moths - Extension

Pine tip moths have typical moth life histories, passing through four life stages: egg, larva or caterpillar, pupa and adult moth It is the feeding of the larval stage that damages originate with eggs laid by the adult female moths, one generation per year The southwestern pine tip moth lays its eggs on buds and new shoots of pines in April

to be effective, however, actual moth habitat (leadplant locations) within a site has to be determined so that it will be divided among the units Research needs: In Michigan the leadplant flower moth is known from only a single location Furthermore, the moth relies on leadplant, a rare prairie plant which occurs in scattered, small populations
